

THE IMPACT OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE

Sexual violence is any sexual conduct that occurs without consent.

Prevalence



- 1 in 5 women & 1 in 71 men** have been **raped** in their lifetime [CDC, 2010]
- 1 in 3 Native American women** Will be **sexually assaulted** [USDOJ, OJP, 2006]
- 1 in 3 women and 1 in 7 men** will experience **unwanted** sexual contact [WCSAP, 2014]

- 1 in 8 lesbian women** have been **raped** in their lifetime [CDC, 2010]
- 4 in 10 gay men** have been **raped** in their lifetime [CDC, 2010]
- 1 in 2 transgender individuals** have experienced **unwanted** sexual contact [Stotzer, R. 2009]

Accountability



- 60%** of rapes and sexual assaults aren't reported [RAINN, 2014]
- 97%** of rapists never spend a day in a prison [RAINN, 2014]

Perpetrators

- 2/3** of rapes were committed by someone known to the victim [DOJ, 2005]

Military Sexual Assault

- The Department of Defense estimates more than **26,000** military sexual assaults occurred in 2012, yet less than **10%** were reported. [DOD, 2012]
- Of those who chose not to report, **47%** indicated fear of retaliation or reprisal as a reason for not reporting. [DOD, 2011]

Campus Sexual Assault

- Less than **5%** of completed or attempted rapes are reported to law enforcement. [NIJ, 2000]
- Among college women, **9 in 10** victims of rape and sexual assault knew their offender. [DOJ, 2000]

Child Sexual Violence

- Three quarters** of reported cases of child sexual abuse are committed by family members or other individuals who are considered part of the child's circle of trust [NCTSN, 2009]
- 12%** of female and **28%** of male victims were raped before age 10. [CDC, 2012]
- 1 in 4 girls and 1 in 6 boys** will be sexually abused before age 18 [WCSAP, 2014]

Women with disabilities

are **raped** and **abused** at a rate at least twice that of the general population [NCDSV, 2015]

Cost

The annual costs for rape victims are greater than any other crime in the U.S.
